# UWI MCGILL COURSES OFFERED IN SUMMER 2016

The University of the West Indies, Department of Biological & Chemical Sciences and McGill University will be offering the following courses in Summer 2016:

<b>BIOL2465-Tropical Horticulture</b>	<b>3 credits</b>	<b>May 25 – June 17</b>
<b>BIOL2050-Sustainability and Land Use</b>	<b>3 credits</b>	<b>June 22 – July 15</b>
<b>BIOL2055-Tropical Energy and Bioprocessing</b>	<b>3 credits</b>	<b>July 20 –August 12</b>
<b>BIOL3901-Multidisciplinary Project</b>	<b>6 credits</b>	<b>May 24 - August 18</b>

The last three courses are taught by McGill faculty and are open to Cave Hill students subject to the approval the Head of the Department of Biological & Chemical Sciences. Each of the 3-credit courses is taught over four weeks. Practical work will be conducted in the lab and/or in the field.

The Multidisciplinary projects are conducted by teams of students, often from varied disciplines. Projects offered relate directly to local needs.
