### **Grambling State University Cooperation Scholarships 2010**

The Government of Barbados in collaboration with Grambling State University, Grambling, Louisiana, United States of America is inviting applications from suitably qualified candidates for the award of partial scholarship at undergraduate and graduate levels with effect from January 2010 in the following areas:

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicants should be citizens of Barbados between the ages of eighteen (18) and forty-five (45).

#### **ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS**

Graduate applicants must have:

- (a) a minimum of 3.5 G.P.A on a 4.0 scale
- (b) a copy of GRE/GMAT scores and other documents as required by the University.

Undergraduate applicants must have:

- ◆ a copy of SAT SCORES (a minimum score of 1090 (Math and Verbal) or ACT scores (composite 24) or must take upon arrival.
- ◆ A minimum of five (5) CXC General/GCE 'O' Level passes including Mathematics, English Language and a Science subject.

## VALUE

### **UNDERGRADUATE**

The partial scholarship covers US\$ 5,886.00 per year of the US\$15,364.00 per year cost of the programme. The remaining annual cost to a student is US\$9 478.00 per year. This includes tuition, room and board, and international student fees.

### **GRADUATE**

The partial scholarship covers US\$6 863.50 of the US\$13 727.00 per year cost of the programme. The remaining cost to student is US\$6 863.50 per year. This covers tuition, room and board, and international student fees.
