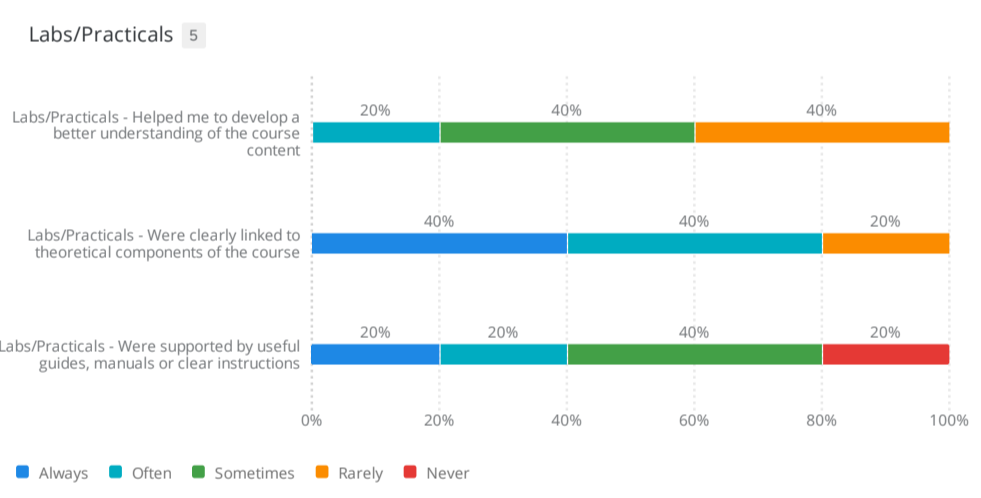

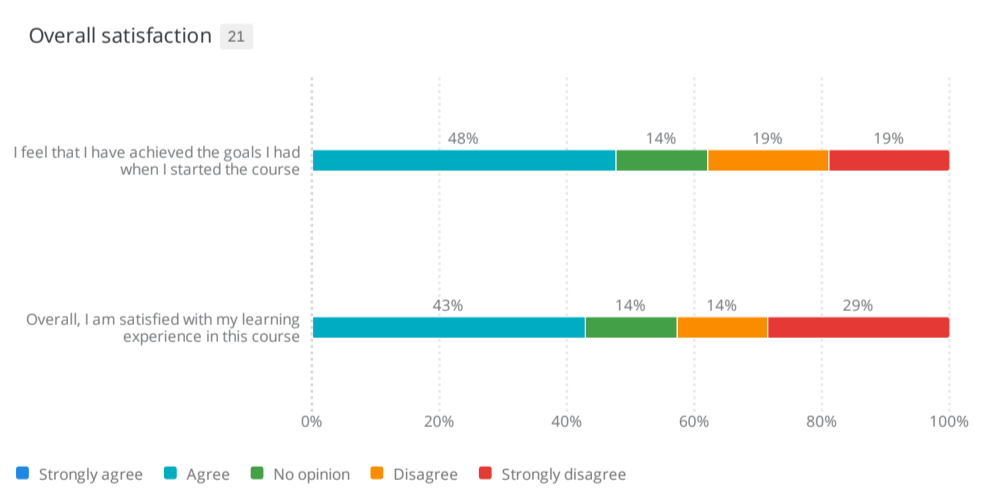

The work load could be broken down a bit more

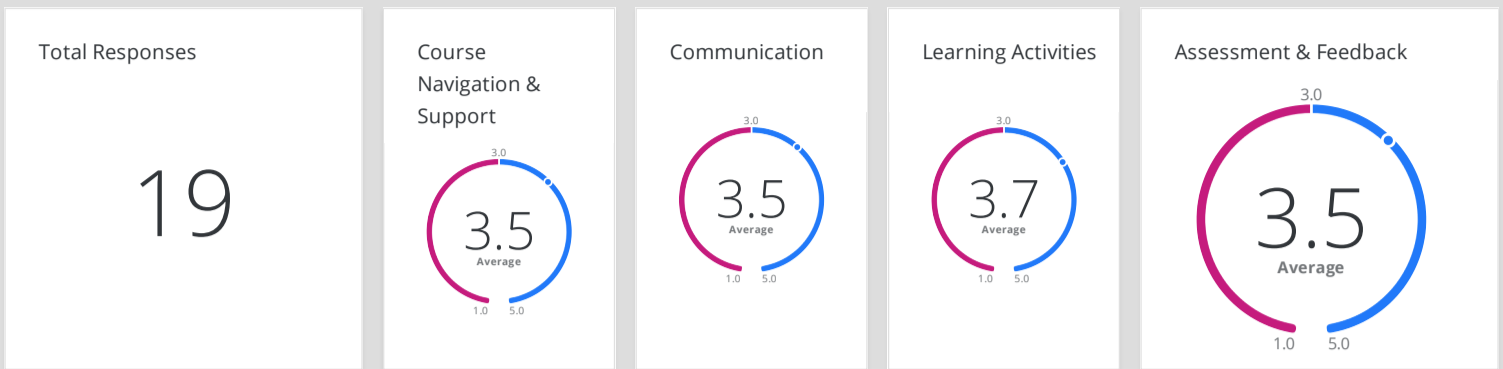
More discussions

More practical examples rather than theoretical.

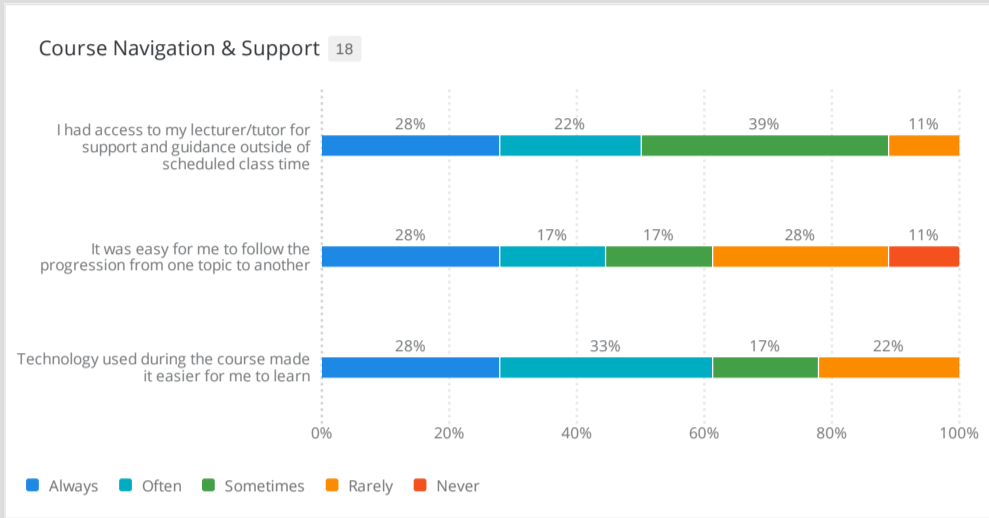
This course would be best as a 100% course to be honest or at least a 60% course to accommodate the amount of assignments given. Better course material should also be provided

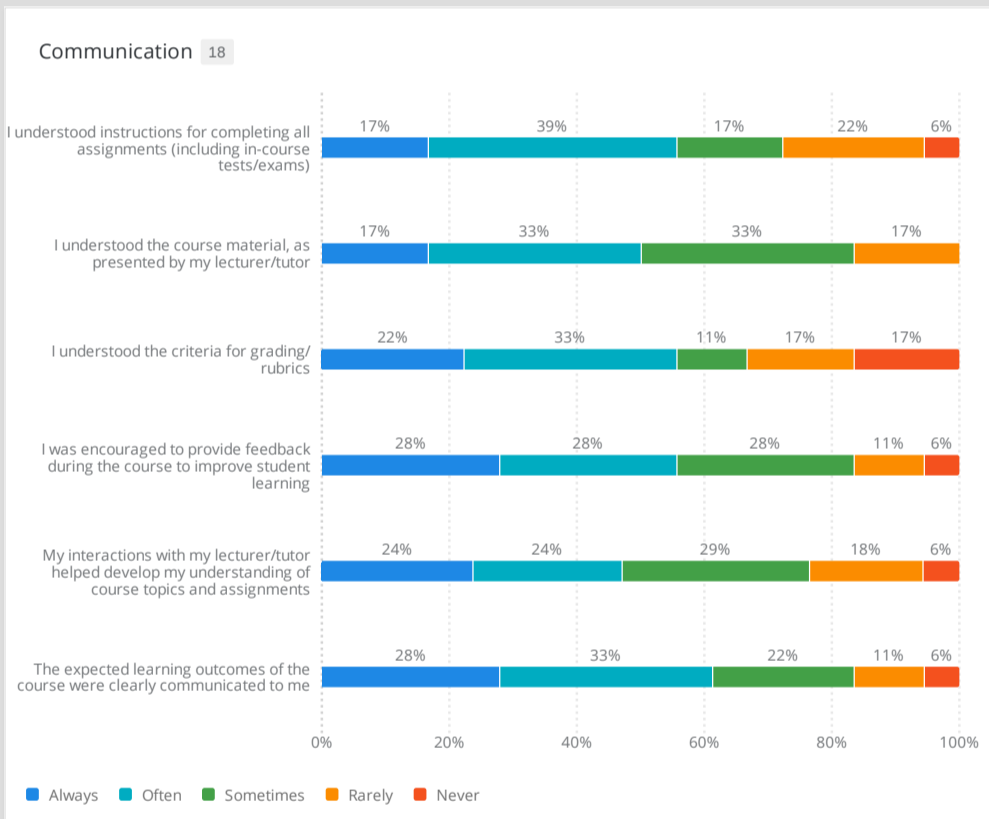

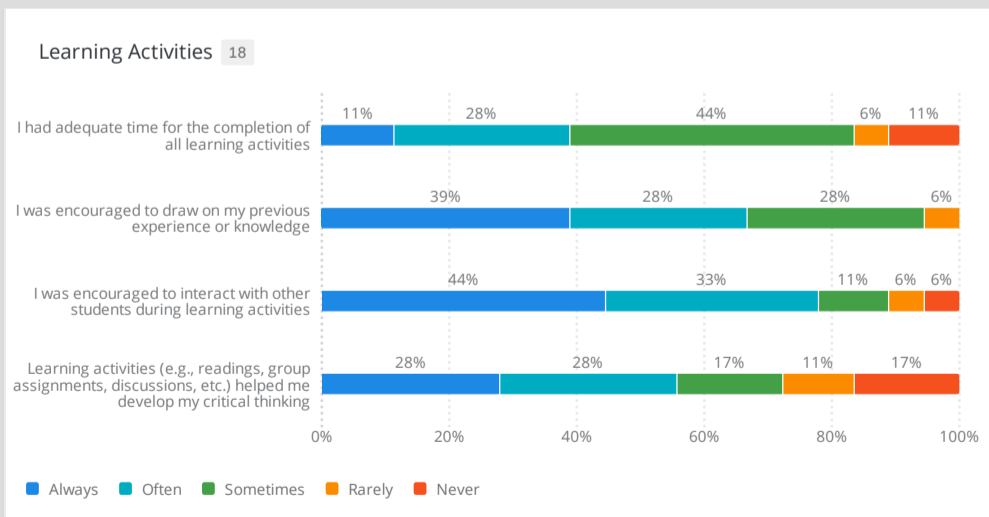

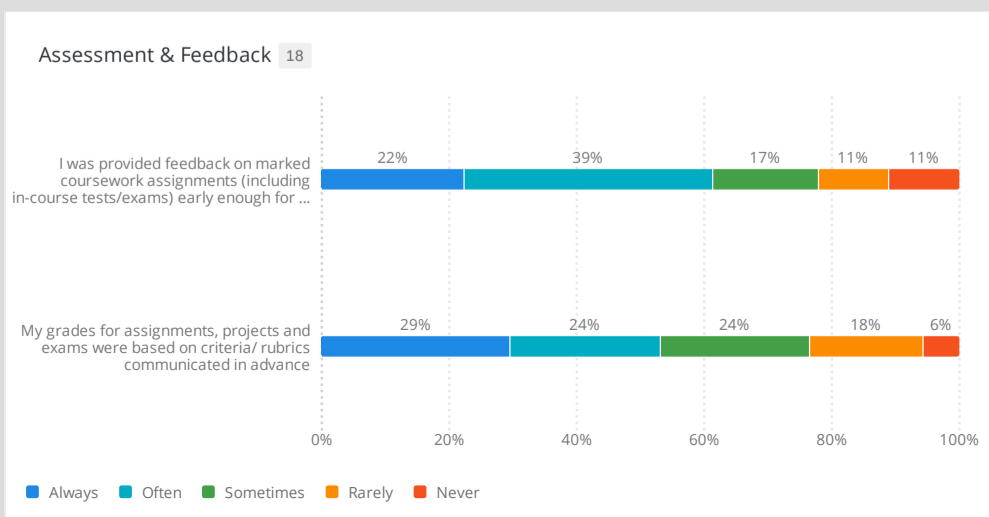
