Fighting for Ground: Tensions between Anglicanism and Roman Catholicism in Early Barbados

ABSTRACT – The emergence of religion in Barbados is inextricably linked to British colonization of the island in the 17th century. Therefore, the socio-political, and economic conditions, which dictated how the religious beliefs and ceremonies of British and Irish citizens were experienced, transferred to the increasingly diverse population in Barbados. This paper assesses the development of Anglicanism and Catholicism in the colony. It also examines the methods used by the Protestant, Barbadian planter class to control the religious and social practices of Catholics. Consideration is also given to the experiences of Irish Catholics who came voluntarily or were exiled to Barbados.
