† Prerequisites: Pass in English Proficiency Test OR Exemption from Proficiency Test OR Pass in FOUN0100. Students with none of these prerequisites should register and pass FOUN0100 Fundamentals of Written English before attempting any of the Foundation Language courses.

‡Please note that students who possess Grade I or 2 CAPE Communications Studies may be exempted from taking FOUN1001. However, this is not for credit and the student would be required to take another Level I Foundation Language course.
