**GRANT REGULATIONS**

**A. NAME OF GRANT**

1. The grant shall be called **Talcie and Carl Springer Grant** and shall be tenable at The University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus, Barbados.
2. One award shall be available each academic year for a period of three years, from 2026-2027 to 2028-2029.

**B. PURPOSE OF GRANT**

3. The purpose of the award is to provide support to students pursuing the Master of Science in Nursing MScN degree.

**C. ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD OF STUDY**

4. The award shall be open to nationals of Barbados who:
  - i. are accepted to read or for a full-time postgraduate degree in Nursing Administration or Education;
  - ii. have demonstrated an exceptional capacity for a high level of academic performance and achieved a GPA of at least 3.0 at the undergraduate level.
  - iii. can provide adequate documentary support of financial need as requested by the Scholarship Review Committee.

**D. DURATION OF GRANT**

5. The award is for a period of one (1) year.

E. **VALUE OF GRANT**

6. The value of the Grant shall be BDS\$ 2000.
7. This award shall be applied to the payment of tuition fees, maintenance costs, books, materials, subsistence.

F. **TENURE OF GRANT**

8. Continuation of the Grant shall be subject to reports of good conduct and academic progress on the part of the Grant holder. The Grant may be withdrawn at the discretion of The University under advice to the donor if the awardee fails to maintain this standard.

G. **ADVERTISEMENT AND SELECTION**

9. The availability of the Grant shall be suitably advertised by The University of the West Indies.
10. The University of the West Indies will receive the applications for shortlisting. The shortlist will be forwarded to the donor to make the final selection.
11. An awardee's acceptance of the grant permits The University and the donor the right and permission to use the awardee's name, voice, photograph and likeness for advertising or any other purpose in any media format without further compensation, permission or notification to/of the awardee.
12. In the event that no suitable candidate is identified for the grant in a given academic year, the offer of the grant shall be deemed withdrawn for that year and will not be awarded.

H. **FINANCIAL PROCEDURE**

13. The **Talcie and Carl Springer Grant** will be funded through payment of a sum of BDS \$2000 in pursuance of Regulation E.6 above directly to The University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus no later than August 1<sup>st</sup> in each year of the award.
14. The annual amount will be disbursed by The University to the grant holder over two semesters after the deduction of any relevant University fees or charges.
15. In the event that no suitable candidate is identified for the grant in a given academic year, the designated funds advanced to support the unawarded grant shall be carried forward to the subsequent academic year and disbursed in accordance with the regulations governing the award of the grant.

16. The grant amount, criteria and conditions are subject to review at the end of the grant cycle.
