**The Hui Family Postgraduate Scholarship
for the Study of Physics**

SCHOLARSHIP REGULATIONS

A. NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. The scholarship shall be called **Hui Family Postgraduate Scholarship for the Study of Physics** and shall be tenable at The University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus, Barbados.
2. One scholarship will be available each academic year from 2025-26 to 2029-30, inclusive.

B. PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP

3. The purpose of the award is to assist students pursuing a full-time Master of Philosophy (MPhil) degree in Physics.

C. ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD OF STUDY

4. The award shall be open to students of all nationalities who:
 - i. are accepted to read for a **full-time postgraduate** degree in Physics in the Faculty of Science and Technology.
 - ii. have demonstrated an exceptional capacity for a high level of academic performance and achieved a GPA of at least 3.0 at the undergraduate level.
 - iii. have provided adequate documentary support of financial need as requested by the Scholarship Review Committee. Shortlisted students may be required to provide an 800-word essay to support their financial circumstances.

D. DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

5. The award is for a period of one (1) year.

E. VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP

6. The value of the Scholarship shall be USD\$5,000.
7. This award shall be applied to the payment of tuition fees, maintenance costs, books, materials subsistence.

F. TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIP

8. Retention of the Scholarship shall be subject to reports of good conduct and academic progress on the part of the Scholarship holder. The Scholarship may be withdrawn at the discretion of The University under advice to the donor if the awardee fails to maintain this standard.

G. ADVERTISEMENT AND SELECTION

9. The availability of the Scholarship shall be suitably advertised by The University of the West Indies and the donor.
10. The University of the West Indies will receive the applications for short listing and selection. The donor permits The University to make the final selection.
11. An awardee's acceptance of the scholarship permits The University and the donor the right and permission to use the awardee's name, voice, photograph and likeness for advertising or any other purpose in any media format without further compensation, permission or notification to/of the awardee.
12. In the event that the scholarship cannot be awarded to a suitable candidate pursuing postgraduate studies in Physics in a given academic year, the award may be considered for reallocation to a postgraduate student who meets the eligibility criteria for the Hui Family Postgraduate Scholarship for Environmental Studies, as outlined in the regulations governing that award. Such reallocation shall be subject to the approval of the Scholarship Review Committee. If no suitable candidate is identified under either scholarship category, the offer of the scholarship for that academic year shall be deemed withdrawn and will not be awarded.

H. **FINANCIAL PROCEDURE**

13. The Hui Family Postgraduate Scholarship for the study of Physics will be funded through payment of a sum of USD\$5,000 in pursuance of Regulation E.6 above directly to The University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus no later than August 1st in each year of the award.
14. The annual amount will be disbursed by The University to the scholarship awardee over two semesters after the deduction of any relevant University fees or charges.
15. In the event that the scholarship is not awarded in a given academic year, the designated funds advanced to support those unawarded scholarships shall be carried forward to the subsequent academic year and disbursed in accordance with the regulations governing the award of the scholarship.
16. The scholarship amount, criteria and conditions are subject to review at the end of the scholarship cycle.
