Minimum Qualifications

- A Master's degree in the respective discipline or subject matter for which he/she is applying would be an asset.
- A Bachelor's degree or professional designation/certification in the specific subject area.

Requirements

- Good working knowledge of the Internet and use of Microsoft Office products as teaching aids.
- Good written communication skills for interacting in the online environment.
- Sensitivity to the needs of students from diverse settings and backgrounds.
- Experience in teaching/training adult learners at the tertiary education level, in the public sector or in the industry.
- Persons who have formal qualifications in the academic discipline and also have practical experience working in the field will enjoy an advantage.
- Persons with professional teacher qualification and/or experience teaching will have a distinct advantage.

Training

Successful candidates will be required to complete UWI Global Campus training in online instruction, technology software and curriculum requirements prior to the start of teaching.

Remuneration

Tutors will be paid a fixed fee on satisfactory completion of all assigned tasks. All fees will be subject to relevant statutory payments.
