## SECTION 1: GENERAL INFORMATION

---

### Definition of a Student

A person is considered a student at The UWI only if he/she has registered for courses and paid all required fees for a given semester, or has made satisfactory arrangements with the Bursary for the payment of fees.

### Categories of Students

Fees payable by students pursuing postgraduate degrees and diplomas at The University of the West Indies are set periodically by the University Council and calculated based on country of citizenship, faculty, programme category, and registration status.

There are two main categories of Students – Regional and International.

Regional Students – there are two (2) categories:

- Citizens of countries that contribute financially to the recurrent budget of The University (Contributing Countries)
- Citizens of countries that do not contribute financially to the recurrent budget of The University (Non-Contributing Countries)

Contributing Countries are further divided into Campus Countries (countries where UWI physical campuses are located) and Non-Campus Countries. Students who are not recognised as Regional Students are classified as International Students.

The full list of Contributing and Non-Contributing Countries is provided in Section 2.

### International Students

- Students who are not recognized as regional students are classified as international students.

### Categories of Programmes

For financial purposes, there are two categories of programmes:

- University Grants Committee (UGC) Funded Programmes – programmes supported in part by the contributing countries of the university through the UGC. These attract fees comprising Tuition Fees and Economic Cost (see Section 4, Part A, and the programme list on page 6).
- Self-Financed Programmes – programmes for which students pay the full cost. These attract a fixed total Tuition Cost per programme (see Section 4, Part B).

---

## Categories of Fees

There are two main categories of fees payable by all postgraduate students:

- University Registration Fees – miscellaneous fees including the Amenities Fee, Guild Fee, and Science Fee (Science & Technology students only). These are mandatory for ALL students.
- Programme Fees – calculated based on country of citizenship, faculty, programme type, and registration status.

## University Registration Fees 2025/2026

University Registration Fees are mandatory for ALL students, including sponsored students and scholarship holders. They may be paid in two instalments at the start of each semester or in full at the start of the academic year. These fees must be paid BEFORE the start of the registration process and are non-refundable.

Every student must also pay a one-time ID Card fee on first registration. Replacing a lost ID Card also incurs this fee.

## Registration

The University's Academic Year is divided into two main semesters (Semester 1: August – December; Semester 2: January – May). There is also a summer term applicable only to self-financed programmes.

A student may register either full-time or part-time. Registration is completed online via the student administration system (CHOL). You are required to register for every programme element each semester – course, thesis, workshop, seminar, or research paper. The online course selection must be completed before Programme Fees can be generated; however, University Registration Fees must be paid before course registration can begin.

You are expected to register during the assigned week of each semester until your degree is awarded. Course registration changes are permitted until the end of the third week of each semester.

## SECTION 3: HOW TO PAY FEES

---

### Payment Obligations

It is your responsibility to ensure that your fees are paid on time. Unpaid fees have serious consequences, including the implementation of Financial Holds that will prevent you from accessing academic facilities such as the E-learning system and the Library, and will result in restricted access to examination rooms.

You are not recognised as a student of The UWI until you have completed registration AND paid your fees or made satisfactory arrangements with the Bursary to do so.

### How to Pay

Fees can be paid in full at the start of the academic year or by semester. The Cave Hill Campus offers flexible Payment Plans to assist students with the payment of Programme Fees only. University Registration Fees cannot be included in a Payment Plan and must be paid in advance of registration.

### Government and Sponsored Students

If your fees are being paid by your government or another sponsor, you **MUST** request that the government or sponsor submit a letter confirming this before or during the registration period. The University submits invoices for payment to governments and sponsors by the end of the third week of each semester.

**GOVERNMENTS OF NON-CAMPUS CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES** have different arrangements regarding sponsorship. It is your responsibility to confirm any level of government sponsorship and present the University with written confirmation. You must also ensure that you can cover any portion of the fees not covered by your sponsor.

**ALL STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT SPONSORED BY THEIR GOVERNMENT ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FULL PAYMENT OF ALL THEIR FEES.**

### Nationals of Barbados

Sponsorship by the Government of Barbados is limited to students in UGC-funded programmes with at least an Upper 2nd Class Honours undergraduate degree. The Government of Barbados will pay both Tuition Fees and Economic Cost for the normal duration of the programme, plus one (1) additional year where applicable. After this period, you will be billed directly for all fees.

For self-financed programmes under "[Areas of National Significance](#)", government sponsorship covers only the stated cost of one programme for the set number of credits. If you take additional courses, fail, or have to repeat a course, the cost of the additional course(s) must be covered by you, and will be billed to your account. E.g. the cost of MSc Tourism and Sports Management is \$30,000. Government will be billed up to \$30,000 for 42 credits, and any balance due to repeats or additional courses is to be borne by the student. Students who are allowed to switch between programmes should be aware that the above policy also applies. The Government will be billed

for the cost of one (1) programme only, based on the number of credits associated with that programme. Any credits/costs over the maximum to be billed to the government will be billed to the student.

## **Outstanding Balances**

Continuing students who have outstanding balances on their accounts must settle those arrears BEFORE they can register for a subsequent semester.

### **Note to Scholarship Winners**

If you have a scholarship or other award, please ensure you have sufficient funds to cover at least one month's expenses, as sponsorship payments are normally delayed.

## SECTION 4: TUITION AND OTHER FEES 2025/2026

---

### Part A: UGC-Funded Programmes

Programme Fees in UGC-funded programmes comprise Tuition Fees and Economic Cost. The tables below show annual fees. Fees per semester are half the annual amounts shown.

#### Fee Structure by Country of Citizenship

- **BARBADOS (Campus Country):** The Government of Barbados pays BOTH Tuition Fees and Economic Cost on behalf of eligible Barbadian nationals. Subject to sponsorship criteria (see Section 3).
- **JAMAICA / TRINIDAD & TOBAGO (Campus Countries):** The governments of Jamaica and T&T pay the Economic Cost only. Students from these countries are responsible for paying the Tuition Fees shown in the Campus Countries columns.
- **ANTIGUA & BARBUDA (Campus Country):** Students pay both Tuition Fees and Economic Cost as shown in the Campus Countries columns.
- **OTHER NON-CAMPUS CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES:** Students pay Tuition Fees plus the Economic Cost which is calculated based on a discount of approximately 66%.
- **NON-CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES (including International Students):** Students pay the One Fixed Fee shown.

## Part B: Self-Financed Programmes

Self-Financed Programmes are programmes for which students pay the full Tuition Cost. Most are Taught Masters or Postgraduate Diplomas with an overall Tuition Cost for a stated number of programme credits. The portion of fees payable each semester is calculated pro-rata after course selection and is due by the end of the Registration period.

**NOTE: All students in Self-Financed Programmes are responsible for the full payment of their own fees, regardless of nationality, unless specifically sponsored by their government or another sponsor.**

### Self-Financed Programmes with an Overall (Total) Tuition Cost

Self-Financed Programmes are programmes for which students pay the full Tuition Cost. Most are Taught Masters or Postgraduate Diplomas with an overall Tuition Cost for a stated number of programme credits. The portion payable each semester is calculated pro-rata after course selection.
