## SECTION 1: GENERAL INFORMATION

### Definition of a Student

A person is considered to be a student at The University of the West Indies only if he/she has registered for courses and paid all required fees for a given semester, or has made satisfactory arrangements with the Bursary for the payment of fees.

### Categories of Students

Fees payable by undergraduate students at The University of the West Indies are set periodically by the University Council and are calculated based on country of citizenship, faculty, programme, and registration status.

There are two main categories of Regional Students:

- Citizens of countries that contribute financially to the recurrent budget of The University (Contributing Countries)
- Citizens of countries that do not contribute financially to the recurrent budget of The University (Non-Contributing Countries)

Contributing Countries are further divided into Campus Countries (where physical UWI campuses are located) and Non-Campus Countries. Students who are not recognised as Regional Students are classified as International Students and pay the same rates as Non-Contributing Countries.

The full list of Contributing and Non-Contributing Countries is provided in Section 3.

### Categories of Fees

There are two main categories of fees payable by all undergraduate students:

**University Registration Fees** – mandatory miscellaneous fees including the Amenities Fee, Guild Fee, ID Card fee, Pelican Perks Advantage Programme (PPAP) fee, and Science & Technology Fee (for Science & Technology students in the Departments of Biological & Chemical Sciences and Computer, Mathematics & Physics only). These must be paid before course registration begins and are non-refundable.

**Programme Fees** – consisting of Tuition Fees and Economic Cost, calculated each semester based on your country of citizenship, faculty, programme, and course load (full-time or part-time).

### Full-Time vs Part-Time Registration

A student registered for twelve (12) or more credits per semester is considered Full-Time. A student registered for a maximum of nine (9) credits per semester is considered Part-Time. The number of credits you register for determines the Programme Fees payable.

**NOTE:** Students in receipt of a three-year offer may register full-time or part-time. Students with a four-year offer may only register part-time at Level I. The Faculty of

Science & Technology is the ONLY faculty that offers three and four-year full-time programmes. The LLB (Faculty of Law) and MBBS (Faculty of Medical Sciences) are full-time only.

## University Registration Fees 2025/2026

University Registration Fees are mandatory for ALL students, including sponsored students and scholarship holders. They may be paid in two instalments at the start of each semester or in full at the start of the academic year. These fees must be paid BEFORE course registration and are non-refundable. Every new student also pays a one-time ID Card fee on first registration.

## How Programme Fees Are Calculated

Programme Fees comprise Tuition Fees and Economic Cost. They are generated automatically once you complete online course registration via the Cave Hill On-Line (CHOL) student administration system. The fees are recalculated each semester based on the courses you select. Course registration changes are permitted until the end of the third week of each semester; fees are adjusted accordingly.

How the fee tables work:

- **BARBADOS (Campus Country):** The Government of Barbados pays BOTH Tuition Fees and Economic Cost on behalf of eligible Barbadian nationals. Sponsorship is not automatic and is subject to specific criteria — see Section 2.
- **JAMAICA / TRINIDAD & TOBAGO (Campus Countries):** The governments of Jamaica and T&T pay the Economic Cost. Students from these countries are personally responsible for paying the Tuition Fees shown in the Campus Countries column.
- **ANTIGUA & BARBUDA (Campus Country):** Students pay both the Tuition Fees and Economic Cost shown in the Campus Countries columns.

- **OTHER NON-CAMPUS CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES:** Students pay Tuition Fees plus a discounted Economic Cost (approximately 66% discount applied to the full Economic Cost). Confirm your government's commitment before accepting your place.
- **NON-CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES / INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS:** Students pay the One Fixed Fee shown.

## SECTION 2: HOW TO PAY FEES

### Payment Obligations

It is your responsibility to ensure your fees are paid on time. Unpaid fees result in Financial Holds that prevent access to the E-learning system and will bar you from examinations. You are not recognised as a student of The UWI until you have completed registration AND paid your fees or made satisfactory arrangements with the Bursary.

You are expected to complete your registration during the assigned Registration Week at the start of each semester so that your fees can be promptly generated and paid.

You are permitted to make changes to your course registration until the end of the third week of the semester. Your fees will be adjusted accordingly.

### Payment Plans

The Cave Hill Campus offers flexible Payment Plans for Programme Fees only. University Registration Fees cannot be included in a Payment Plan and must be paid before course registration.

### Government and Sponsored Students

If your fees are paid by your government or another sponsor, you **MUST** submit a written confirmation letter before registering. The University invoices governments and sponsors by the end of the third week of each semester. Any invoice not honoured becomes the student's personal responsibility.

**GOVERNMENTS OF CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES have different arrangements regarding sponsorship. It is your responsibility to confirm any level of sponsorship from your government and to present The University with a letter of confirmation of this sponsorship before taking up your place.**

**ALL STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT SPONSORED BY THEIR GOVERNMENT ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FULL PAYMENT OF ALL THEIR FEES.**

### Nationals of Barbados

The Government of Barbados pays both Tuition Fees and Economic Cost on behalf of Barbadian nationals. Sponsorship covers the regular period for programme completion plus a maximum of one additional year. Sponsorship does not

automatically apply to self-financed programmes such as the MBBS and the BSc in Human Nutrition and Dietetics, where funding is limited to a set government quota. There are also restrictions regarding funding for a second undergraduate degree.

### **Nationals of Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago**

The governments of Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago pay the Economic Cost portion of Programme Fees. Students from these countries are personally responsible for Tuition Fees.

### **Nationals of Trinidad & Tobago**

Nationals of Trinidad and Tobago should know that the government manages education funding through the means-tested GATE program. For more details on eligibility for GATE funding, students can visit the GATE website, call 800-GATE, or email [gate.info@gov.tt](mailto:gate.info@gov.tt).

Note that the funding provided to students is based on the cost of the equivalent programs at the St. Augustine Campus, except for the MBBS program and any programs not available there. Your student account will be updated to show GATE funding once your GATE application status indicates "**CLEARANCE APPROVED.**"

### **Outstanding Balances**

Continuing students who have outstanding balances on their accounts must settle those arrears **BEFORE** they can register for the next semester.

### **Government Sponsorship — Non-Campus Contributing Countries**

Governments of Non-Campus Contributing Countries have varying sponsorship arrangements. It is each student's responsibility to confirm in writing what their government will cover before accepting a place.

### **Scholarships and Bursaries**

Over 100 scholarships from corporate and private donors are available for undergraduate students at Cave Hill Campus.

### Understanding Your Annual Fees

A worked example is provided below to show exactly how your annual fees are calculated. The example uses a programme and walks through three categories of students — Campus Country, Non-Campus Contributing Country, and Non-Contributing Country / International — showing what each student owes after adding Programme Fees and University Registration Fees together. Part-time amounts are shown alongside full-time amounts. Simply find your faculty section, read your category row, and use the same calculation with your own programme fees.
