Name of Scholarship

REGULATIONS

NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. The Scholarship shall be called The Gregory Straughn Scholarship and shall be tenable only at The University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus (The UWI).

ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD OF STUDY

2. The Scholarship aims to support the research of full-time postgraduate students currently enrolled in the Faculty of Science and Technology at The University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus.
3. Potential candidates should have completed at least one postgraduate course and presented at least one seminar on his/her research work.
4. **Area of Study:** The Scholarship shall be open to any postgraduate student in the Faculty of Science and Technology who is pursuing MPhil or PhD research in the area of sustainability.
5. **Academic Achievement:** Applicants for the scholarship must be in good academic standing and have demonstrated strong motivation, commitment and enthusiasm for research.

DURATION OF AWARD

6. The Scholarship shall be for a period of one academic year and cannot be held jointly with other awards without permission from the Faculty of Science and Technology.

VALUE OF AWARD

7. The value of the award shall be BDS\$3,000 per annum to be used in meeting the student's maintenance costs, fees and incidental expenses.

TENURE

8. The continuance of the Scholarship shall be subject to reports of good conduct and good satisfactory academic progress to be submitted annually by The University of the West Indies. The scholarship may be withdrawn at the discretion of The University of the West Indies if the student fails to meet the criteria set out in the letter of award.

ADVERTISEMENT AND SELECTION

9. The availability of the Scholarship shall be suitably advertised by The University of the West Indies.
10. Applications should be submitted via The UWI's Scholarship applications online portal.
11. The award of the Scholarship shall be based on their academic performance in the coursework and satisfactory progress report(s).
12. The Faculty of Science and Technology Scholarship Committee shall make the final selection of the candidate for the award.

13. An awardee's acceptance of the scholarship permits The UWI and the donor the right and permission to use the awardees' name, voice, photograph and likeness for advertising or any other purpose in any media format without compensation, permission or notification to, or of, the awardee.

FINANCIAL PROCEDURE

14. The donor shall, not later than 01 August in each year of the duration of the Award, pay to The University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus, a sum of BDS\$3,000, in pursuance of Regulation 6 above.
15. The annual amount will be disbursed by The UWI to the scholarship holder in two semester allotments.
16. The scholarship amount, criteria and conditions are subject to a joint review on an annual basis between Mr Gregory Straughn and The University of the West Indies.
