Thank you for considering The University of the West Indies at Cave Hill, Barbados!

This brochure provides information on fees for international students in undergraduate and graduate degree, diploma and certificate programmes, and students joining us for Study Abroad or Medical Electives.

There are two main categories of fees payable by international students annually, Tuition Fees and University Registration Fees.

Fees are quoted in United States Dollars (USD) - \$1USD = \$2BBD (Barbados Dollars)

UNIVERSITY REGISTRATION FEES

University Registration Fees include a number of miscellaneous fees that are payable at Registration. These include a **Guild Fee** and an **Amenities Fee** payable by **all** students, and a **Science Fee** for students in the Faculty of Science and Technology only. **These fees are mandatory for ALL students, including sponsored students and scholarship holders**, and may be paid in two installments at the start of the first and second semester, or in full at the start of each academic year. Every student must also pay a one-time fee for an ID card, payable on first registration. Replacement of lost ID cards also carries this fee.

Effective academic year 2024-25, undergraduate students also pay a ***Pelican Perks Advantage Programme (PPAP) Fee*** of BBD\$20.00 (USD\$10.00) per year, for three years. The fee goes towards their lifetime membership in The UWI Alumni Association, and the associated benefits of that membership.

University Registration Fees must be paid BEFORE the start of the registration process and are non-refundable.
