PART-TIME STUDENT STATUS

Entry Requirements:

- 5 CSECs or GCE O'Levels (English A compulsory, plus specific subjects based on programme)

Course Load per Semester

2-3 courses per semester until completion of Level One courses

FULL-TIME STUDENT STATUS

Entry Requirements:

- 5 CSECs or GCE O'Levels (English A compulsory, plus specific subjects based on programme)
 - 2-3 CAPE or A'Levels (depending on programme)
- OR
- Associate Degree with GPA of 2.5 or above (depending on programme)

Course Load per Semester

4-5 courses per semester

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Part-time and full-time status does **NOT** determine whether classes are held during the day or evening - both may attend classes at various times.
- The distinction is based on the number of courses/credits you are permitted to take per semester.
- Part-time students become eligible for full-time status after completing Level One courses.

Status Flexibility

Full-time students: Have the option to register as part-time if desired.

Part-time students: Can only register as full-time after completing all Level One courses.
